A MESSAGE FROM MSGR. GIBBONS

Camino Pilgrimage: Important Information Meeting on Feb. 5th If you're planning on walking the Camino de Santiago in Spain with Msgr. Gibbons

in September 2025----or if you're trying to decide whether to register----you're invited to an Information & Preparation Meeting on Wednesday, February 5th, at 6:00 p.m. in the Parish Center.

Msgr. Gibbons has invited to the meeting (1) a podiatrist (who had made the Camino) to share his expertise about how to care for your feet during the walk; (2) a track coach from a local high school to share her recommendations about how best to prepare for the walking; and (3) a veteran Camino pilgrim (who has done the same trip itinerary with the same travel company we are using) to share from his experience.

Dates for the pilgrimage trip are September 15-25, 2025. Presently 28 people are registered and have paid their deposit. Space is limited, so don't hold back on registering. Full details and the registration form are available here:
