Cornerstone Celebration – 100 Years

Bishop Patrick Barry of St. Augustine laid the cornerstone of St. Paul's first building on February 15, 1925. The cornerstone is still visible at the northeast corner of the school building, where 12th Street N. and 20th Avenue N. intersect. According to the St. Petersburg Times report, "several hundred persons" gathered on that Sunday afternoon with the bishop and with the priests of St.

Mary's Church (the mother church of St. Paul's) to celebrate the start of construction of the school building and the adjacent "chapel" (our present gymnasium/auditorium.)

Our current bishop, Bishop Parkes, will be here at St. Paul's on Friday, February 14th, to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the laying of the cornerstone. A prayer service will be held at 8:00 a.m. on the School Entrance Plaza. All parishioners are invited to join with the St. Paul's School community for the occasion. A light reception will be held on the North Courtyard after the ceremony. We look forward to sharing this milestone celebration with all of our school and parish families.
